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1. About Global Environment Centre



GEC is a Non-Governmental Organization (NGO) and Non-Profitable Organization (NPO). GEC was established in 1998 to work on environmental issues of global importance. The Centre is registered in Malaysia but works regionally and internationally both directly and through many partners. It supports information exchange and capacity building as well as undertakes strategic projects particularly in developing countries. It works in partnership with other like-minded agencies worldwide.

2. About Raja Musa Forest Reserve

Raja Musa Forest Reserve is located near Batang Berjuntai/Berjuntai Bestari in the northern region of the Selangor State, Together with Sungai Karang Forest Reserve, it makes up the largest peat swamp forest complex in Selangor. It is approximately 23, 000 ha. in area cover and of this 1000 ha were degraded due to illegal encroachment. These areas are in dire need of rehabilitation effort.

Unfortunately, over the past ten years more than 600 ha of the reserve has been illegally cleared and burnt for farming activities and has caused major environmental hazards such as haze. Clearing and fires have also released thousands of tons of greenhouses gases, which contribute to climate change.

Even though the degraded areas are situated within the forest reserve and falls within the jurisdiction of Forestry Department, it is an enormous task to undertake even for a government agency to rehabilitate 1000 ha of the degraded areas. Hence, collaboration between Forestry Department with NGOs and local community in this matter was deemed crucial. This happens to provide the local community with a platform to work hand in hand with the government agency and at the same time, spend more time to understand about the functions and values of peat swamp forest while planting the trees.

3. Planned Activities for Raja Musa Forest Rehabilitation Programme (Monthly based) For Year 2013

Raja Musa Forest Rehabilitation Programme is one of the important activities at Raja Musa Forest Reserve aimed at conserving the various species of peatswamp and restoring the deteriorated area to its former glory, retaining the original characteristics of the peatland forest. Peatland forest is the most important ecosystem globally for preventing global warming and Malaysia has the third largest surface area in the world made up of this type of forest.

The first objective of the rehabilitation is to stop peatland fires and haze and help prevent global warming and create forest cover which further prevents encroachment into the forest, thus reducing the risk of fire. This activity was created to provide hands-on experience on

conservation and a great opportunity to explore and to know better the importance and function of the Raja Musa Forest Reserve.

Planting site: a) Forest Compartment 99 & 100 (5 times)

b) Forest Compartment 73 (4 times)

Objective:-

- a) To instill awareness on an important conservation and preservation of the Raja Musa Forest Reserve (Peatswamp)
- **b**) To create an awareness regarding on the climate change and its effects to Raja Musa Forest Reserve (Peatswamp)
- c) Providing hands-on experience and creating ownership among the participants to conserve the Raja Musa Forest Reserve (Peatswamp)

3.1 Monthly Tree Planting Campaign at Raja Musa Forest Reserve

Since 2008, GEC had managed to rally more than 2,000 volunteers for the numerous tree planting events that has taken place at this site. So far more than 30,000 tree seedlings have been planted in an area covering some 60 hectares, with various stakeholders and corporate partners' support.

Raja Musa Forest Rehabilitation Programme will conducted every month (on 2^{nd} or 3^{rd} Saturday of the month) to rehabilitate the Raja Musa Forest Reserve.

Activity 3.1.1: Forest rehabilitation (Planting Programme)

- I. Land preparation and marking for tree planting activities (for 1 ha)
- **II.** Supplying 400 saplings for Planting Programme

Field Planting, Methods and Materials

Open planting technique involved clearing of existing plants especially the Imperata cylindrica to eliminate unwanted competition and provide easy access for planting works. The clearing was done in strip of 1 m width by using parang and brushing machine. The direction of planting strip was south to north and 2 m width of existing grass was left uncut to avoid direct sunlight to the planted seedlings. The plot design by hectares (1 ha = $100m \times 100m$), 400 saplings will be plant at a spacing or marked $5m \times 5m$. Dig the planting holes of based on the poly bag prior the planting session. Then, the existing peat was used to cover up the planting holes. Basically, the same method is applied for the other planting techniques.

4.2 Do's & Don'ts


- 1. All plants and wildlife are protected. Please do not collect, harass, damage, injure or kill them.

- 3. Do not collect specimens. Plants and wildlife in the forest reserve belong in their natural habitat.
- 4. Do not litter. Bring out your rubbish with you and dispose it in proper bins provided.
- 5. Please keep noise at a low level. No radios, PA systems and musical instruments, please.
- 6. Do not feed wildlife in forest reserve
- 7. Do not start fires. Fires when out of control will cause untold damage, even camp fires.
- 8. Please inform the officers if you find anyone trapping, logging, open burning, damaging plants or injuring wildlife on park property.
- 9. Take nothing but photographs and leave nothing but footprints. Enjoy your activity.
